"I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution and rules of Equine Canada at this competition. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless EC, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives. The person responsible (PR) agrees to the release of any information on the entry form to EC.

As a participant in the aforementioned ride, I agree to abide by the rules of **EC, OCTRA** and/or **AERC**. I understand that long distance riding involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communication, transportation and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and manmade hazards which can include unpredictable weather conditions, which ride managers cannot anticipate, identify, modify, or eliminate; that horses can be excitable, difficult to control, unpredictable; that accidents can happen to anyone at any time. I agree to take full responsibility for myself and the animal that I am riding. I will hold the ride management, all rider personnel and all property owners, over whose land the ride crosses, blameless for any accident or loss that might occur due to my participation in the ride, and free from liability for such injury or loss. I have read and understand this liability release.
